- Kentucky is the only state that has its own Pro Football Hall of Fame.
- The purpose of the KY Pro Football Hall of Fame is to appropriately honor persons that have brought significant recognition to the state of Kentucky, or have by their unusual successful service achieved significant accomplishment on behalf of their school, or have by a significant act or contribution distinguished themselves as an unusual former National Football League player, coach, referee, owner, management, etc., or have been a significant or unusual supporter of Pro Football.

Criteria for Induction

A class of no less than 4 and no more than 8 nominees will be inducted into the KY Pro Football Hall of Fame each year. Only one of the inductees may be deceased. An inductee into the KY Pro Football Hall of Fame must satisfy the qualifications in one of the following two sections.

- Section 1: An inductee will be a former/current National Football League player, coach, referee, owner, management, etc., or have been a significant and/or unusual supporter of Pro Football, ***and who also attended school in the state of Kentucky, but may not reside in the state of Kentucky.***
- Section 2: An inductee will be a former/current National Football League player, coach, referee, owner, management, etc., or have been a significant and/or unusual supporter of Pro Football, and who also ***presently reside in the state of Kentucky.***
